

## Modification to the Methodology of the S&P Sri Lanka 20

**MUMBAI, NOVEMBER 9, 2017:** S&P Dow Jones Indices announces the following change to the methodology of the S&P Sri Lanka 20.

Methodology		
Change	Previous	Updated
Constituent Selection Buffer Rule	The 20 largest companies are selected and form the index, subject to a three company buffer for current index constituents. If a current index constituent is ranked in the top 23, it remains in the index. If not, the company is deleted and the next largest non-constituent company is added until the company count reaches 20.	The top 16 companies (whether a current constituent or not) are selected for index inclusion. Existing constituents ranked 17-24 are selected in order of highest rank until the target constituent count of 20 companies is reached. If after this step the target constituent count is not met, then non-constituents ranked 17-24 are selected in order of highest rank until the target constituent count is reached.

This methodology change takes effect prior to the market open on Monday, December 18, 2017, in conjunction with the implementation of the December 2017 rebalancing.
