

Seacoast Banking Corporation of Florida Set to Join S&P SmallCap 600

NEW YORK, FEBRUARY 14, 2018: Seacoast Banking Corporation of Florida (NASD: SBCF) will replace Deltic Timber Corp. (NYSE:DEL) in the S&P SmallCap 600 effective prior to the open of trading on Wednesday, February 21. S&P MidCap 400 constituent Potlatch Corp. (NASD:PCH) is acquiring Deltic Timber in a transaction expected to be completed on or about February 20 pending final approvals.

Seacoast Banking is a community bank providing financial services. Headquartered in Stuart, FL, the company will be added to the S&P SmallCap 600 GICS (Global Industry Classification Standard) Regional Banks Sub-Industry index.
