Dow Jones Sukuk Indices Consultation on Eligibility Criteria

NEW YORK, JANUARY 28, 2019: S&P Dow Jones Indices ("S&P DJI") is conducting a consultation with members of the investment community on a potential change to the Dow Jones Sukuk Indices.

Currently, Islamic Sukuk Murabaha are eligible for inclusion in the indices, while Islamic Sukuk Hybrid instruments are ineligible. With a goal of better reflecting the Sukuk market, S&P DJI is seeking market feedback on whether Islamic Sukuk Murabaha should remain eligible for index inclusion and if Islamic Sukuk Hybrid instruments should become eligible.

IMPACT ANALYSIS

The following table shows the actual index attributes of the Dow Jones Sukuk Total Return Index (ex-Reinvestment) as well as the hypothetical index attributes that would have resulted had Islamic Sukuk Hybrid instruments been eligible for inclusion at the most recent index rebalancing, effective prior to the market open on January 1, 2019.

- 1. Should bonds with Islamic Sukuk Murabaha structures remain eligible for index inclusion?
- 2. Should Islamic Sukuk Hybrid instruments be eligible for index inclusion?
- 3. If any changes based on questions 1 or 2 are adopted, do you agree with implementing them prior to the market open on Friday, March 1, 2019, in conjunction with the monthly rebalancing?

¹ Due to the minimal issuance of bonds with this structure, the indices currently do not include any Islamic Sukuk Murabaha.

4. Do you have any other comments or feedback regarding the proposed changes outlined above?

Prior to the Index Committee's final review, S&P DJI will consider the issues and may request clarifications from respondents as part of that review. Alternative options to the proposed questions after the deadline require that the consultation be re-opened to the public.
